The Ministry of Higher Education and Science hereby confirms that University College South Denmark is a publicly recognized and state-financed higher education institution regulated by the Ministry of Higher Education and Science. Public higher education institutions in Denmark are regulated by the Act on University colleges of higher education (act no. 562 of 6 June 2007 with later amendments) concerning degree structures, teacher qualifications and examinations. All programmes are accredited by the Danish Accreditation Council.

For all higher education programmes in Denmark, accreditation is mandatory and a precondition for attaining public funding.

As part of the Bologna Process, Denmark has implemented the European Standards and Guidelines for the quality assurance of the higher educations (ESG), and all public higher education study programmes must meet these international quality and relevance standards.

University College South Denmark offers and develops higher education with a strong relation to practice. University College South Denmark offers bachelor and diploma programmes that meet the diversity of interests from different students in a variety of subjects and help secure the needs for a qualified workforce in both the private and the public sector.

University College South Denmark is required to conduct research and to offer research-based education with the aim to contribute to national and regional growth through R&D-based educational programmes.
